

Personal Geographies Project

Due 10/8/2008 (present in class and turn in)

Create an artwork—or a model of an artwork--in any medium, inspired by any sentence from the readings we did on personal geographies. It does not have to illustrate the reading, but rather should take its spirit and direction from the reading.

Your artwork can be whatever you choose: it can be a large project for which you present sketches or models; or a small drawing that you show. It can be a map. It can even be a continuation of the drawing you started in the mapping workshop.

To accompany your artwork or plan, write an artist's statement of no more than a page that reflects the sentence you chose and your creative process in making the work.

You should plan a project that will take you no more than 10 hours total outside of class (including the writing).

I will evaluate based on your engagement with the assignment, your creative engagement with the sentence you choose, your craft, the artist's statement, and your oral presentation in class on 10/8.
